Introducing the New Medical Affairs & MSL Membership – 2026

The Georgia Society of Clinical Oncology (GASCO) is pleased to introduce a new **Medical Affairs/Medical Science Liaison (MSL) Membership** category beginning in 2026. This initiative reflects the evolving role of Medical Affairs professionals in advancing oncology care through scientific exchange, education, and collaboration.

This new membership pathway is designed to:

- Foster **appropriate, compliant engagement** between Medical Affairs professionals and oncology providers
- Support **scientific dialogue and education** aligned with CME standards
- Provide **structured access** to GASCO-hosted meetings and networking opportunities
- Ensure **clear distinction** between commercial and non-promotional activities

Under this model, Medical Affairs and MSL professionals may attend GASCO meetings in a defined, transparent framework that prioritizes education, collaboration, and compliance.

Key highlights include:

- Dedicated registration category for Medical Affairs/MSL attendees
- Unlimited attendance with individual registration required
- Access to designated networking and discussion areas
- Inclusion in GASCO communications and newsletters
- Clear separation from Corporate Partner promotional benefits

Registration Fees: GASCO Corporate Partners - **\$1,000 per meeting**
Industry Attendees: - **\$1,500 per meeting**

GASCO is introducing a dedicated Medical Affairs/Medical Science Liaison (MSL) Membership for 2026. The guidelines below apply to all Medical Affairs and MSL representatives attending GASCO meetings.

Topic	Guideline
Attendance	There is no limit on the number of Medical Affairs and MSL representatives who may attend a GASCO-hosted meeting.
Registration	Each attendee must register individually and select the Medical Affairs/MSL category once registration opens.
Complimentary Passes	Complimentary passes reserved for commercial Corporate Partner representatives are not transferable to Medical Affairs/MSL attendees.
Exhibit Tables	Unused exhibit tables not needed by Corporate Partners <u>may not be transferred</u> to Medical Affairs/MSL attendees, and Medical Affairs/MSL attendees may not purchase exhibit tables.
Badges and Check-in	All attendees must sign in at the registration desk and pick up a badge. To support CME compliance, badges will show only the attendee's name, title, and the GASCO logo; no Corporate Partner name or logo will appear.
Networking and Discussions	Attendees may engage with speakers and member physicians or APPs only in designated networking areas, including common areas, the exhibit hall, or a quiet room GASCO will make available to Medical Affairs and MSL representatives for more private discussions. Advance reservations for the quiet room will not be accepted.
Membership Enrollment	GASCO is implementing a new membership and meeting management system. Once launched, Medical Affairs and MSL staff will be able to join GASCO and manage their own accounts. Included Communications	Membership includes a subscription to GASCO's oncology and pharmaceutical newsletters.

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
